

Anthony Dibrell

Treasurer's Report, 1847 – 1849

Anthony Dibrell served as the fourth State Treasurer of Tennessee from 1847 to 1855. During his time as State Treasurer, Dibrell served under four different governors. The first was Neill Smith Brown who served as the governor of Tennessee from 1847 to 1849. The second governor during Treasurer Dibrell's tenure was William Trousdale who was governor from 1849 to 1851. The third governor was William Bowen Campbell who was governor from 1851 to 1853. Finally, Treasurer Dibrell served under Andrew Johnson who was governor of Tennessee from 1853 to 1857. Anthony Dibrell's Treasurer Report was presented to the State Legislature on October 8, 1849. The report provides an account of the receipts and disbursements of the two preceding years and a balance of the treasury account on October 8, 1849. In addition, the report offers a statement that shows the amount paid out to various institutions and other items.
